At the bottom of the application are three buttons as follows:

- New Click to create a new Keyword Group. A popup window will be displayed where you can enter new keywords. See the next page for more detail.
- Edit Select a Keyword Group and Click the Edit button. A popup window will be displayed where you can enter new keywords, remove and rename keywords. See the next page for more detail.
- Delete Select a Keyword Group and Click the Delete button. This will remove the selected Keyword group, so care should be given before Deleting.

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Deleted Keyword Groups – Undelete Steps

Deleted Keyword Groups are not fully removed. They are relocated and renamed.

There is a manual process to restore a deleted Keyword Group. See the steps below for details.

1. On the Keyword Group panel Click on the Blue Key icon.



2. After clicking on the Blue Key icon, the Windows Explorer will open to the folder where your Keyword Group are held. – Click on the Removed folder.

6. Click "ctrl v" keys on your keyboard to paste the Keyword Group into your folder.

7. Select the Undeleted Keyword Group (xml) file and Right Mouse Click. Select the Rename menu item and Remove the "~" prefix.
